
Aradana TV produces and broadcasts a wide range of creative in-house programs that have spiritually replenished the Christian community. According to the general consensus, some of the most watched programs are:

Preaching Through the Ages:

Adapting the Great Commission with Technology

The Great Commission of Jesus commands us: "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature." In fulfilling this great commission, Christians throughout history have faced various obstacles, restrictions, assaults, persecutions, and pandemic situations, yet they have persevered. These kinds of situations always pose the question to the Christian community: how then shall we preach?

Historically, Christians have been quick to adopt new technologies and communication methods to overcome obstacles in preaching the Gospel. At the time of Jesus, communication methods were limited to oral preaching and scrolls. We refer to the time of Jesus as "The age of orality," during which Jesus preached and taught the Gospel.

In the second century, the codex—a book with papyrus sheets—was invented. All the books of the New Testament were written in this format. In the 15th century, Johannes Gutenberg invented the printing press, and Bibles were among the first books printed, helping to ignite the Reformation. When movies were invented in the early 20th century, Christians quickly saw their power and potential. Some of the earliest

silent films were biblical epics or explored Christian themes.

In 1920, radio-broadcast technology was introduced. Christians like Paul Rader, Bob Jones Sr., Charles Fuller, and Aimee Semple McPherson used this powerful medium to reach audiences in the millions. Later, radio ministries were introduced to Telugu people by FEBA and Viswavani.

When television broadcasting followed, evangelicals swiftly seized its potential. Billy Graham became a household name partly through his use of television. The term "televangelism" soon entered the lexicon. After Aradana TV launched, many Telugu evangelicals like Dhinakaran, Satish Kumar, Shyam Kishore, and Stephen Paul reached millions of people. Then, with the advent of internet services, many churches and individuals began internet evangelism.

In these troubled times, televangelism and internet evangelism are the best media to reach people. Aradana TV provides both television and internet platforms, allowing you to reach millions of people from the comfort of your home.



Thousands of Christians from various churches took to the streets, walking, running, and riding motorcycles and four-wheelers. They waved flags and joyfully shouted, "Christ is risen, indeed Christ is risen!

The largest evangelical and ecumenical rally, "Run For Jesus," was held on Holy Saturday, March 30, 2024. This grand event united both Catholic and Protestant churches to proclaim the crucifixion and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, marking Good Friday and Easter."

The concept of the "Run For Jesus" rally was conceived by the Aradana TV Team in 2011. Initially

organized in over 30 locations, the rally has now expanded to over 500 locations, simultaneously held across Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, parts of Karnataka and Maharashtra, and some international locations. 
Your contributions will be used for the following purposes:
